### **PRN Physical Therapist**

**SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES:** Conforms to all laws, regulations and codes of conduct applicable to professionals in the Allied Medical Field, specializing in Physical Therapy. Comply with the ethics of the American Medical Association and the American Physical Therapy Association. Coordinates and directs patient care and other related activities of the department according to adopted standards. Develops short and long range goals and objectives for the patient to be specifically outlined and identified at established time frames. Reviews and updates goals and objectives of the services offered with each patient visit. Exhibits high level of interest in the field of rehabilitation services and sports medicine. Exhibits a desire to seek knowledge continuously within the field. Possesses a high level of organization, problem-solving and prioritizing skills. Follows age specific criteria when planning patient care and interactions. Demonstrates communication skills which indicate ability to be successful at counseling, encouraging and teaching. Displays an overt exhibition of diplomacy and tact. Shows willingness and ability to educate by sharing of knowledge. Has ability to act quickly and demonstrates follow-through when problems occur. Participates and completes initial orientation and yearly refresher of infection control policies; HIV/AIDS awareness; safety, fire and disaster programs; OSHA rules and regulations; hazardous/toxic materials; age specific competency; and domestic violence. Manages ongoing and continuous self-development and learning.
